Child Care

Our service is to provide child care to area children whose parents are at home or are with an at-home child care provider. Ages will depend upon availability. We will plan for age two through five years. We believe that the children will benefit through combined efforts of the parents and/ or providers and Edu-Care. The children will gain social skills along with building on their developmental skills while participating in our child care.



The high school students are interested in becoming teachers and will gain knowledge through completion of lesson plans and then experiencing first hand learning. The children will gain new experiences through creative activities provided from each of the student's lesson plans. The importance of home and school is taught early in a child's life. What better way to instill that bond, than to work cooperatively at an early age.

Student Teachers

This course is designed to prepare students interested in a career in child care operations and early childhood education with information and practical experiences needed for the development of job-related competencies. Students are expected to develop appropriate skills in program development and in assisting with children's creative activities. Classroom study is concerned with the philosophy and management of care centers and the state and local regulation governing care-giving operations. Students will learn appropriate methods of developing and writing creative program curricula. This course provides the opportunity to implement the main learning experiences that involve creative activities planned in a creative environment for young children.



Edu-Care provides any of the supplies needed by the program. The emphasis is on learning the skills associated with the administration of a day care facility and preparation for post-secondary education in an early child-hood education program. Emphasis is placed on career opportunities , communication skills, and human relations. Students will learn about the responsibilities and characteristics of teachers. They will also learn about the physical, cognitive, social, and emotional development of children and further develop their teaching and observation skills.
